CHAPERONES

We are very appreciative of the presence of the chaperones for the festival. We as directors cannot take on such a large project without the support of volunteers who are willing to assist us with this wonderful festival.

Please be sure your chaperones know the sequence of events for the day. We need the chaperones to be wherever the students move, rehearse. Please ask them to help the directors with the movement to and from the auditorium. When students need to leave the gymnasium, a chaperone should leave with them. I am asking that each school have chaperones in the gymnasium, as well as the auditorium, during the sectional rehearsals. These people know the students from their respective schools better than our guest conductor. We have suggested 1 chaperone per every 10-15 students.

Chaperones will be treated to the Subway dinner option in the cafeteria.

Chaperones from *Lapel, Pendleton Heights, and Elwood* should eat from 4:15-4:45 so they are ready to assist with the evening meals. The chaperones from *Madison-Grant, Frankton, and Alexandria* should eat from 4:45-5:15. When not eating please be sure that the chaperones are assigned to a designated area for your students (whether that be the cafeteria, the dance, or later in the homeroom areas.) It is imperative that we have SEVERAL chaperones in the DANCE area! Directors, please assign your chaperones so that they know where and what times they are to be in the assigned locations of your choice.

Please ask your chaperones to wear a **NAMETAG** during the festival so that we know they are assisting us. These will be available the day of the festival. **These** will also serve as their ticket to the NIGHT concert.
